



SSPP HS Dress Code Policy Reminders and Enforcement

Below is a summary of our student handbook dress code policy. Summer uniforms are worn during the 1st and 4th quarter, winter uniforms are worn during the 2nd and 3rd quarter. *Item links are for reference - only the skirt, skort, short, or pant; polo; blazer and pullover must be purchased from [Flynn O'Hara](#).*

Girls Uniforms

SUMMER UNIFORM FOR GIRLS: To be worn during times as designated in the **Master School Calendar**. The Winter Uniform may also be worn at any time during the school year.

1. **Bottom***– Flynn O'Hara khaki [uniform skirt](#), [khaki skort](#), [khaki shorts](#), or [khaki pants](#) with dark solid-color belt worn at the waistline (no skorts or pants should be tight fitting).
2. **Shirt** – White, button-down Oxford (no logo) or [white](#) or [navy blue](#) school logo polo shirt*. **Only a plain white T-shirt free of writing or imprints may be worn underneath the white polo shirt** (a navy blue T-shirt may be worn with the navy blue polo shirt). Long sleeve T-shirts or turtlenecks may **not** be worn with the Summer Uniform.
3. **Socks** – Must be worn at all times. Non-logo, [Navy blue](#), black or [white](#) color socks.
4. **Tights** – Navy blue, black, or white tights; or plain, non-colored/non-patterned nylons may be worn with the Summer Uniform.
5. **Dress Shoes**– Flat black, brown, tan, or navy **leather** dress shoes. No logo sneakers, boots, backless, slippers, or cloth shoes. Shoes must be tied properly at all times.
6. **Pullover (optional)*** – School logo [¼ zip pullover](#), [sweater](#) or [vest](#). No other jackets, sweaters, or sweatshirts may be worn.

WINTER UNIFORM FOR GIRLS: To be worn during times as designated in the **Master School Calendar**.

1. **Bottom*** – Flynn O'Hara khaki [uniform skirt](#), [khaki skort](#), or [khaki pants](#) with dark solid-color belt worn at the waistline (no skorts or pants should be tight fitting).
1. **Dress Shirt** – White long-sleeve button-down Oxford (no logo) or white turtleneck. **Only plain white undergarments/T-shirt/turtleneck free of writing or imprint may be worn underneath the dress Oxford shirt.**
2. **Socks** – Must be worn at all times. Non-logo, Navy blue, black or white color socks.
3. **Tights** – Navy blue, black, or white tights; or plain, non-colored/non-patterned nylons may be worn with the Winter Uniform.
4. **Dress Shoes** – Flat black, brown, tan, or navy leather dress shoes. No logo sneakers, boots, backless, slippers, or cloth shoes. Shoes must be tied properly at all times.
5. **School Blazer (Required)*** – Students will wear a [school logo navy blue blazer](#).
6. **Pullover (optional)*** – [¼ zip school logo pullover](#), [sweater](#), [vest](#) (except when the blazer is required). No other jackets, sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn.

Boys Uniforms

SUMMER UNIFORM FOR BOYS: To be worn during times as designated in the *Master School Calendar*. The Winter Uniform may also be worn at any time during the school year.

1. **Dress Pants*** – Flynn O’Hara khaki uniform trousers ([adult](#) or [youth](#)) or uniform [shorts](#).
2. **Shirt** – White, button-down [Oxford](#) (no logo) or [white](#) or [navy blue](#) school logo polo shirt. **Only a plain white T-shirt free of writing or imprints may be worn underneath the white golf shirt (a navy blue T-shirt may be worn with the navy blue polo shirt).** Long sleeve T-shirts or turtlenecks may **not** be worn with the Summer Uniform. Uniform appropriate ties are to be worn with the button-down dress Oxford shirt at all times.
3. **Belt** – Black or brown leather.
4. **Socks** – Must be worn at all times. Plain, non-logo [Navy blue](#), black or [white](#) socks.
5. **Dress Shoes** – Flat black/brown/tan/navy leather dress shoes. No logo sneakers, boots, backless, slippers, or cloth shoes. Shoes must be tied properly at all times.
6. **Pullover (optional)*** – School logo [sweater](#) or sweater [vest](#). No other jackets, sweaters, or sweatshirts may be worn.

WINTER UNIFORM FOR BOYS: To be worn during times as designated in the *Master School Calendar*.

1. **Dress Pants*** – Flynn O’Hara khaki uniform trousers ([adult](#) or [youth](#)).
2. **Dress Shirt** – White, button-down [Oxford](#) (no logo) or white [turtleneck](#). **Only a plain white T-shirt free of writing or imprints may be worn underneath the shirt.** Uniform ties are to be worn with a button-down dress Oxford shirt at all times.
3. **Belt** – Black or brown leather.
4. **Socks** – Must be worn at all times. Plain, non-logo [Navy blue](#), black or [white](#) socks.
5. **Dress Shoes** – Flat black/brown/tan/navy leather dress shoes. No logo sneakers, boots, backless, slippers, or cloth shoes. Shoes must be tied properly at all times.
6. **School Blazer (Required)*** – Students will wear a school logo navy blue blazer. [Adult](#) or [youth](#)
7. **Pullover (optional)*** – School logo [pullover](#), [sweater](#), [vest](#) (except when the blazer is required). No other jackets, sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn.
8. **Necktie*** – Grades 9-11 must wear the official school tie. Grade 12 may wear an appropriate tie of their own choosing.

Uniform Examples



Full Mass Uniform

Required for all **monthly masses and school assemblies** as notified by administration. School blazers may be worn in the winter at any time, but must be worn on mass days in place of the ¼ zip.

School Logo Polo Shirts and ¼ zips optional with skirts/pants/shorts, and shoes.

School tie and Oxford shirt to replace polos, pants/skirts required, ¼ zip or Blazer optional.

Shoe Policy

Leather dress shoes are expected to be worn at all times. If you require alternative footwear, please turn a Doctor's note into the main office by the first Monday in September for medical approval, and ensure that the alternative footwear is not a logo sports sneaker. There are a variety of leather top sneakers available. Please see the administration with any questions about the alternative footwear.

Athletic Teams Game Day Dress Code

Athletic teams may choose to dress in a team uniform to promote team unity on competition dates. All team members are expected to dress up if teams elect to do so. Students may **exceed the dress code with more formal attire, or dress in matching team sweatshirts, uniform tops, or warm up shirts that have been approved by the administration, along with the school uniform bottom and shoes.** No sneakers, t-shirts or casual pants should be worn on competition days. Varsity jackets may be worn on game day competitions, and as a Senior privilege at any time.

Uniform Infraction Policies

The demerit system will be closely monitored at morning meeting report time of 8:30, and in classes throughout the day. **For any uniform infraction, students will be issued a Demerit** that will be tracked in a Google form by all Faculty. Upon the accumulation of a **3rd demerit, a general detention will be issued by administration.** Students will not be issued multiple demerits for the same dress code infraction in 1 day. Following a 3rd demerit infraction, a general detention will be assigned for the remainder of the semester for each continued dress code violation. Appropriate skirt length and proper shoe attire will be strictly enforced throughout the school year following a 2 week grace period at the beginning of the academic year. As a reminder, slip-on shoes such as Hey Dudes, Uggs, and logo athletic sneakers are not to be worn to school on uniform days. For "Tag" dress down days, students may wear any shoes or sneakers to school.

Handbook Policy Regarding Demerits

General Detentions are given for more serious offenses of the Saints Peter & Paul High School Code of Conduct or after the accumulation of three **Demerits.** **General Detentions** are cumulative by semester. Detention is held on Tuesday and Thursday from 3:10-4:00 p.m. Students receiving a **General Detention** will serve it on the next available day providing a 24 hour notice has been given. **Extracurricular activities do not excuse students from serving General Detentions on the assigned day.** Cutting General Detention will result in an additional General Detention. Students are to be in proper uniform compliance while serving General Detention.
