



Admissions Policy & Information

Incoming 9th Graders

To be eligible for admission, prospective students must have satisfactorily completed 8th Grade. Upon receipt of a completed Admissions Application and all necessary records of testing and grades, the student and parent/guardian are interviewed by a member of the Admissions Team. The priority of acceptance to Saints Peter & Paul High School is as follows:

- ☐ Siblings of Saints Peter & Paul students/alumni or children of alumni
- ☐ Catholic parishioners of Saints Peter & Paul Parish
- ☐ Other Catholics
- ☐ All others

Transfer Students

A student wishing to transfer to Saints Peter & Paul High School from another secondary school be subject to the above criteria. He/She must also meet the following considerations:

- ☐ Passing all academic subjects at present school
- ☐ Able to satisfy all necessary graduation requirements of Saints Peter & Paul High School
- ☐ Have no major disciplinary or attendance issues at present school

In the case of admission applications beyond the capacity of the class, a waiting list will be created.

Required Documentation for Admission

New students to Saints Peter & Paul High School must provide the following documentation prior to formal admission to the school:

- ☐ State-issued birth certificate
- ☐ Copy of baptism certificate (if Catholic)
- ☐ Health Inventory completed within the last year
- ☐ Current immunization certificate
- ☐ Official school records, transcript and teacher recommendations from previous school
